This year all the people of the United Church of Christ have a new and special opportunity...to attend the denomination's first fully virtual General Synod, taking place July 11-18th. Personally, I have attended General Synods in Kansas City, New Haven, and the Twin Cities. I enjoyed them all immensely, especially the times of worship.

The cost for visitors (non-delegates) is just \$100.

According to the website: while the agenda is still a work in progress, broad outlines are taking shape. Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday sessions will begin at 7:45 p.m. and end at 11 p.m. ET. There will be about 50 workshops available to attend. Finally, one thing the church does at General Synod is deliberate and vote on Witness Resolutions. 

Consistory Minutes of Meeting April 18, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 8:39 am by President Margaret Stouffer.

Devotions were given by Pastor Ruzicka.

Work of the Church: Effective May 3, 2021 the following will occur:

- Continue wearing masks in and out of service and can be removed during service if fully vaccinated and the member feels comfortable doing so.
- 2. Continue opening windows at the altar.
- 3. First Saturday Meals and Fundraising meals will now do in-person or to go
- Grace's Closet to open on Mondays, Wednesdays, & Fridays starting
 May 3
- 5. Communion will be delivered and the offering plates will be passed

Agenda Additions & Subtractions: Corrected date for Education Sunday to 6/13

<u>Consent Agenda</u>: On a Sydnae/Carolyn motion the consent agenda was unanimously approved after the correction date for Education Sunday.

Information Agenda:

Activities Committee: Laundry Love – delayed resuming until this summer due to close proximity of the laundromat. Ham & soup sandwich-Chet reported all is in order. Continued work for the Breakfast and Sidewalk Sales Days Yard Sale.

Building & grounds: Mark reported a problem with the refrigerator and it has been repaired by Priest's Refrigeration. Mark is checking on cleaning the carpets. Jeff will be replacing moldings at the elevator. John Lehman is to fix the ceiling at the top of the stairs into the sanctuary for \$5,000.00. Repair of roof was completed by Dependable Roofing; however, it will cost \$11,500.00 to have Dependable Roofing paint the roof. Due to this amount being over \$10,000.00 per the bylaws, a congregational meeting needs to be held and voted on. That meeting is scheduled for May 23rd after service. Of note, the Guild made a \$1000.00 donation towards this project. It was noted the flag & stand on the altar needs attention and Ed and Gladys Doyle have agreed to take it to Baer Signs for repair.

Parsonage Payment Plan: Payment for the month of March still has not been received...supposedly lost in the mail. An investigation is pending and we have determined to waive the late fee upon arrival. April was paid by Pay Pal. The contract has been signed by Pastor Brenda and Mike and notarized; however, we have not received a hard copy — only a snap shot. Interestingly, we were to have received this in February. Pastor Brenda's W-2 was returned with an insufficient address. Marg reached out for a new address and once again it came back so she contacted Carrie through the Conference for a new address and to date, that has not come back. Once again, Larry will reach out to Mike for a hard copy of the signed contract.

Finance Committee: Columbia Gas of PA has informed us of a rate increase of 26 to 28%. Insurance coverage for the church has now changed to Brethren Mutual with a considerable savings.

Homebound Outreach: Is still in the works. There are a few more people that need to be reached and once the information is passed onto Cathy, the directory will be updated and completed.

Guest Pastors: Pastor Mark will be attending his son's confirmation on May 16th and Carolyn suggested a gentleman who is a waiter at B Street and also a minister who would love to perform the service on that day. Carolyn will get more information on him. Additionally, Pastor Mark has secured guest pastors for the month of July while he will be visiting family in Wisconsin.

Action Agenda: The Greencastle Boro Council reached out to Margaret about possible renting the social hall for added space when Council meets. Wi Fi is needed for their meetings in the social hall so a motion by Sydnae/Chet to approve \$120.00 for Steve to get that set up and was passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.

The next meeting will May 16, 2021 at 8:30 am in the Social Hall.
