## **From the Pastor's Desk.....**

I decided to have a Sermon Series for September. It is based on the book called *Get Their Name: Grow Your Church by Building New Relationships* by Bob Farr, Doug Anderson, and Kay Kotan. This book is about helping people in our churches to move past the fear of inviting or sharing our faith with others...and moving toward an active, passionate missionary lifestyle.

The reason I chose this one is because many people are asking how the church can grow in the environment in which we find ourselves these days. One thing that seems true to me is that we can't keep waiting for people to arrive at our doors; that doesn't seem to be working well. The other thing that seems true is that we need help to learn to invite others to worship and church events. The author Bob Farr (a United Methodist Pastor) quotes the statistic that, on average, each Methodist member invites someone to come to worship once every 38 years! We can do better than that!

September 15: *"The Person Behind the Need"*

## *Wednesday Night Book Study Group:*

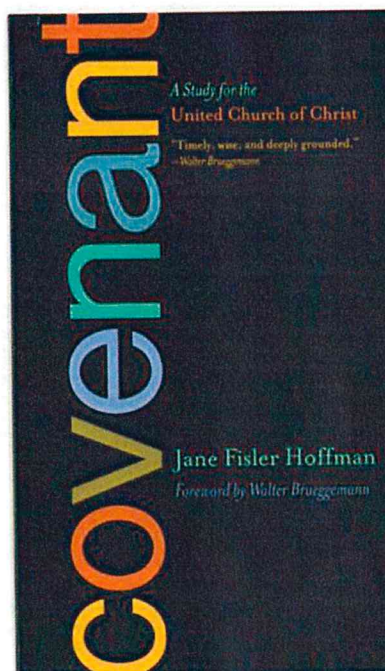
### *“An Introduction to Covenant and the United Church of Christ”*

*Beginning on September 11, Pastor Mark will lead a BOOK GROUP on Wednesdays from 6-7 pm in the Chapel. This study is an opportunity to learn about the United Church of Christ.*

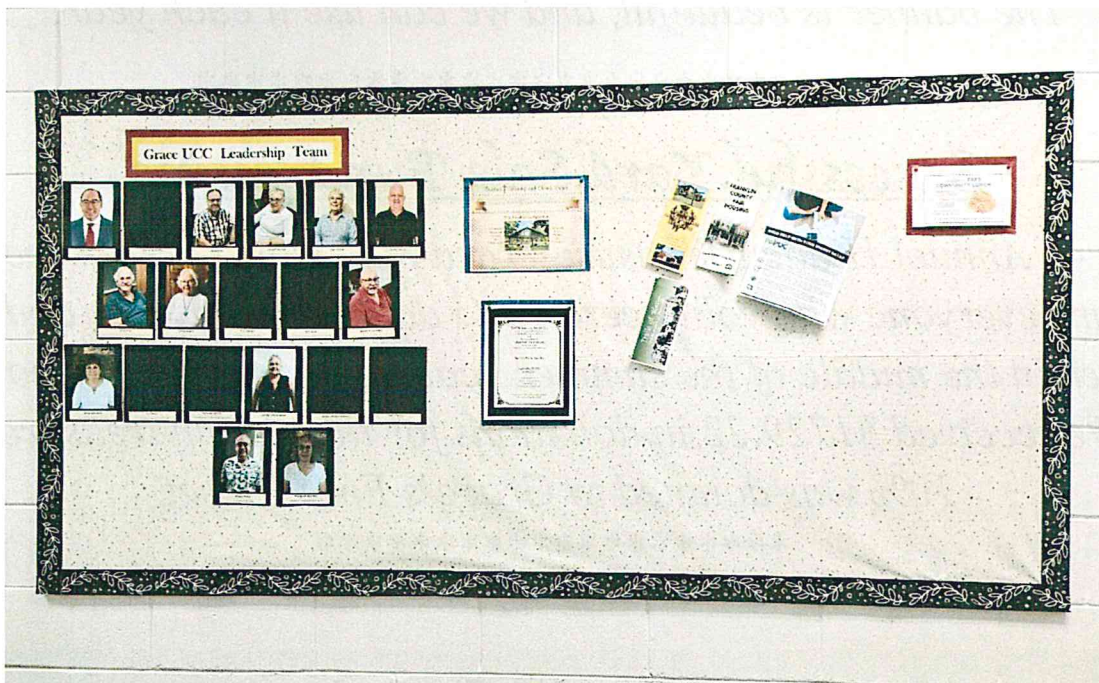


## ORGAN FUNDRAISING / REFURBISHING

We reached our goal of \$62,000 for the organ project! We thank everyone for their donations making these repairs possible! The refurbishing of our Moller Organ will begin sometime in 2025, and it will take 3 to 6 months to complete. This two manual pipe organ was GUCC's 3<sup>rd</sup> Moller Organ which was dedicated in 1953. It uses the church's original 1880 organ pipes. For more organ history check out our website!

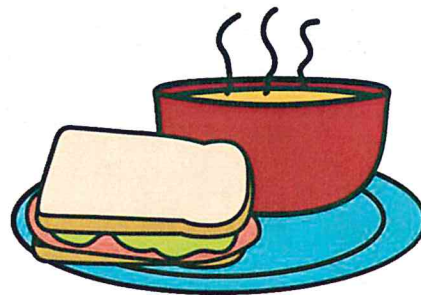


# OCTOBER Fundraiser
