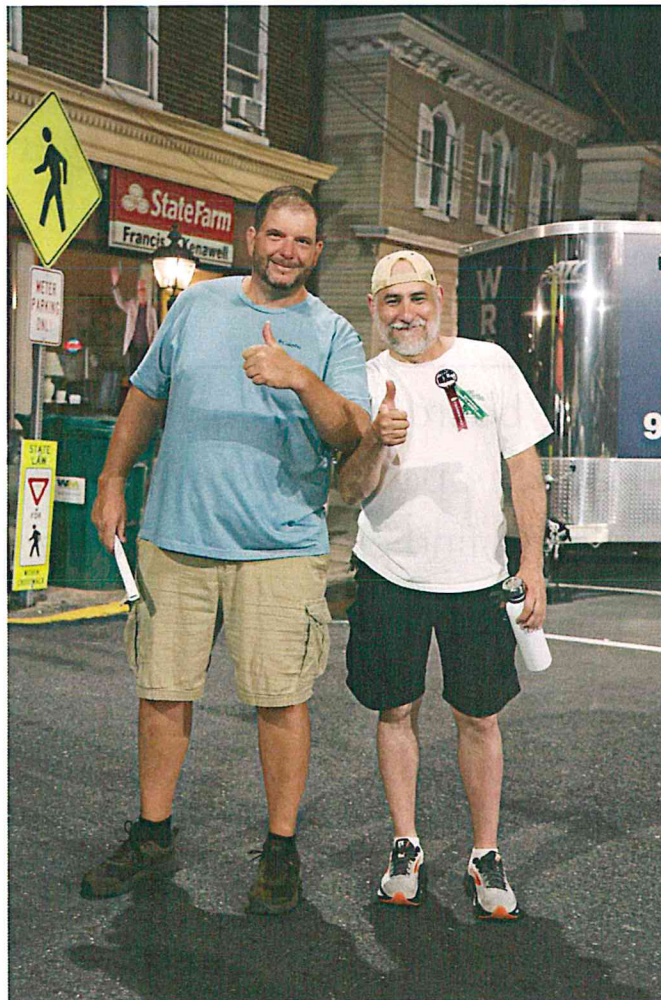

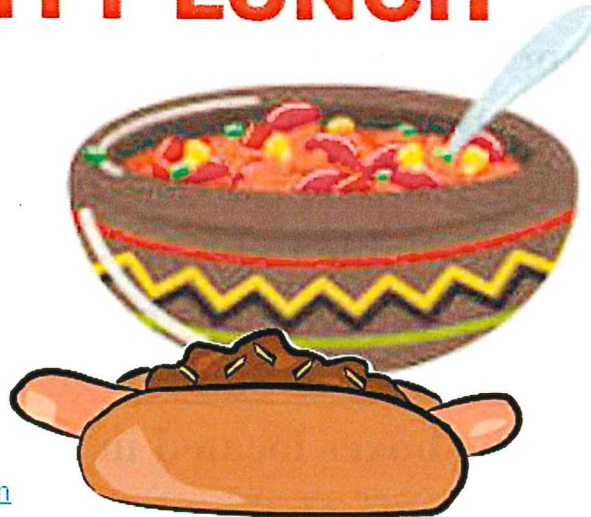

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### **CONSISTORY MEETING**

**JUNE 11, 2025**

Meeting called to order at 6:01pm by President Lorna Thomas.

ROLL CALL: Mark Stahl, Ron Shafer, Deb Homer, Tim Bryan, Barry Shoemaker, Lorna Thomas, and Pastor Mark, were present, Lue Miller, and Steve Miller were present via phone. Treasurer Larry Stepler was also present.

DEVOTIONS: Pastor Mark read selections from Psalms 37.



## CONSENT AGENDA:

1. The May minutes were approved with on a Tim/Barry motion.
2. The Treasurer's Report was approved on a Ron/Tim motion.

## INFORMATION AGENDA:

### Building and Grounds Committee:

1. Garage rentals are paid up until the end of this year. Consider increasing rent for 2026.
2. The two estimates for air conditioning replacement for Social Hall were discussed. On a Steve/ Barry motion it was decided to go with Premier HVAC Services. The cost comparison of the two companies is attached to minutes.
3. The roof replacement was the next discussion. Dependable Roofing was the only estimate we have so far. Barry is trying to get at least one more estimate. We need to move forward with this project because the roof is leaking into one of the Sunday school rooms.

### Activities/Fundraising Building and Grounds Committee:

1. Next big fundraiser is our Annual Hidden Treasures indoor yard sale on July 11 & 12.

### Finance Committee

1. We need to verify with our insurance company to make sure we have enough coverage on the organ.

### Additional Topics for Discussion:

1. The congregational annual business meeting will be Sunday, November 9, 2025.
2. Need more members to volunteer for ushers/greeters.

Meeting called to order at 8:10 a.m. by President Lorna Thomas.

ROLL CALL: Mark Stahl, Ron , Deb Homer, Tim Bryan, Barry Shoemaker, Lorna Thomas, were present, Lu Miller and Steve Miller were present via phone. Treasurer Larry Stepler was also present. Ron Shafer and Pastor Mark were absent.

**INFORMATION AGENDA:**

**Building and Grounds Committee:**

4. Three estimates for roof were discussed, Dependable Roofing, Inc., Bonded Applicators, Inc., and Happy Home. It was decided to exclude Happy Home so we would just have two estimates to discuss. After discussing both companies, it was passed on a Mark/ Steve motion to take Dependable Roofing estimate to the congregation for their approval. It will be 2 to 3 months until Dependable can get to our roof, but we are told if we have any problems in the meantime they will come and do a temporary repair at no charge.
5. Safety issues were discussed. It was decided that the doors will be locked at 9:40am on Sunday morning. Mark Stahl is going to be responsible for locking doors. Ring Doorbell was discussed but no decision was made on this.

**Finance Committee**

2. Larry said the two projects we are looking at (air conditioning and roof) are \$79,000.00. Using the money we have in our accounts and money already donated we have about \$37,700.00. We can use some of our investments if we can't raise the rest of the money.

Co-President Mark Stahl started the meeting at 10:18am. He went over the two topics that needed attention. The first was the air conditioning in the Social Hall. We need to replace both units; the ones we are replacing are 36 years old. The replacements will be heat pumps, which give heat and air conditioning. It should be a cost savings on our heating bill. The total to replace both units is \$23,597.00. The consistory has recommended going with Premier HVAC Services, they currently service our system. Premier says they will have the work done by our yard sale on July 11-12.

The next item is the rubber roof and part of the shingled roof needs replaced. There is a leak in one of the Sunday school rooms and part of the ceiling has come down. The cost of roofing is \$56,018.00, with a 15-year warranty. The consistory recommends going with Dependable Roofing for this project. Dependable says it will be 2-3 months until they can get to our job, but if we have any more leaks they will come and fix for free.

Larry Stepler explained some ways we can fund these two projects. We did get a check for \$4900.00 from the insurance company for damages. We have investments of \$378,000.00 if we have to dip into them. There already have been some special donations for these projects, which are greatly appreciated.

Next was to take a congregational vote for approval to spend the money on these two projects.

The vote came back 100% to go ahead with these projects.
